Please check with the Office of Student Aid / Enrollment Service Center **PRIOR** to requesting in-state tuition, as other financial aid may be impacted by the decrease in cost of attendance.



World Campus students, please note that you are charged an in-state tuition rate regardless of residency, therefore, no action is required on your part.



Please note that students using any component of [VA Education benefits](#) already receive in-state tuition, therefore, no action is required on your part.



According to Penn State's policy regarding residency appeals, the request must come from the student. This's an excerpt from the policy: While supporting letters from parents or guardians can be included in the appeal for the Committee's consideration, absent extraordinary circumstances, the student must be the individual to submit the request for appeal. The University will not entertain appeals submitted by a parent or legal guardian.
